The Rev. Canon Neal O. Michell is Canon to the Ordinary with the Diocese of Dallas. He is married to Varita. The Michells have four children, one son-in-law, and a daughter-in-law, and another son-in-law on the way.

A former practicing attorney, Canon Michell has served churches of various sizes in the dioceses of West Texas and West Tennessee. The Michells planted a church in Germantown, Tennessee which achieved parish status within nine months of its first Sunday service.

In addition, he has served as a consultant in congregational development and led vestry retreats and workshops, focusing on vision-casting and leadership development. He publishes a monthly congregational development newsletter.

He has been awarded a Doctor of Ministry in Church Growth from Fuller Seminary. His doctoral dissertation is "Contemporary Anglican Worship in a Postmodern Era." He has also gone on short-term mission trips to Ukraine, South Africa, Mexico, and was part of a church planting team in Danli, Honduras.

In addition to serving as Canon to the Ordinary, he is currently the Vicar of Trinity Episcopal Church, Dallas, Texas.
